

## STAMBAUGH TOWNSHIP BOARD

### Regular Meeting

The meeting of the Stambaugh Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Isaacson on December 14, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. at the Stambaugh Township Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call was taken with Supervisor Isaacson, Treasurer Rogers, and Trustee Pangrazzi in attendance. Absent: Clerk Christensen and Trustee Stolberg.

The minutes were read from the November 9, 2022, meeting and accepted as read.

Supervisor Isaacson read the bills for the month and Treasurer Rogers made a motion to approve the bills as read with a second by Trustee Pangrazzi. Bills were approved.

Treasurer Rogers read the Treasurer's report which was accepted as presented.

Zach Hautala stated that the Christmas in Lights event was a huge success with 29 participants. He praised the WIC Firemen for their fireworks display. His housing update was regarding an apartment complex that they hope will be built within the next two years.

The #1 well on Hill Road is working; we just need to contact Kleiman to finish the project. Permit is here.

If our budget allows we may have a water project for next year.

The new tires were put on the Township truck and Wyatt's did an alignment.

2023 road projects will include University, Brule, and Krans Roads. Stambaugh Township will be responsible for 25% of the Krans Road project.

Craig at Wickwire can provide us with information to apply for the State's Sparks Grant for Holmes Park.

The Fire Department is in good shape.

The Zoning Appeals meeting was held. Mark & Laura Erhart had not applied for building permits, but presented information and pictures from another property owner on Tamarack Lake that also had buildings in that range. The decision was made that the building would have to be moved back 10-15 feet and they were granted the variance.

The hall is rented for Christmas Eve. Trustee Pangrazzi will make sure it is cleaned and Water Supervisor Johnson will plow, if needed.

The City of Iron River sent Eagle Grant information for water. We currently have a formal agreement with the neighboring townships where we all help each other out. This Eagle Grant would legalize it. No action was taken at this time as the ongoing agreement is working.

The Township is in need of a part-time person to read meters, cut grass, and assist Water Supervisor Johnson with maintenance. Russ Johnson is interested in the position. Treasurer Rogers made a motion to hire Russ Johnson with a second from Trustee Pangrazzi.

Our next regular meeting will be held on January 11, 2023.

Trustee Pangrazzi made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Treasurer Rogers. Meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
