

STAMBAUGH TOWNSHIP BOARD

Regular Meeting

The meeting of the Stambaugh Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Isaacson on January 12, 2022, at 7:00 pm at the Stambaugh Township Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call was taken with Supervisor Isaacson, Clerk Christensen, Treasurer Rogers, and Trustees Pangrazzi and Stolberg present.

The minutes were read from the December 8, 2021, meeting and accepted as read.

Clerk Christensen read the bills for the month and a motion was made by Trustee Stolberg to approve the bills with a second by Treasurer Rogers. Bills were approved.

Treasurer Rogers read the Treasurer's report which was accepted as presented.

Bob Cole was questioning which part of Baumgartner Road will be completed in 2022. Supervisor Isaacson stated that Baumgartner Road will be redone from Dan Wester's residence to Snipe Lake Pub. Snipe Lake Pub to Ski Brule (Brule Mountain Road) is slated as Phase 2 for 2025.

University Road will also be completed in 2022.

We have paid \$27,451.64 of our Covid Relief Money to Kleiman Well Drilling for work on the new #1 well. We have a balance of \$28,388.86 remaining of the money. Kleiman Well Drilling is waiting for parts they have on order to continue the project.

Waste Management is increasing their pricing for garbage pickup.

A Planning Commission meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, January 12, 2022, to discuss the application for the second cell tower by Golden Lake.

Our Assessor, Mari Negro, would like to add a page to the Stambaugh Township website for public access.

There will be Cemetery and Fire Board meetings this month.

Treasurer Rogers made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second by Trustee Pangrazzi. Motion carried with adjournment at 7:40 p.m.

Our next meeting will take place on February 9, 2022.
